Job Description Custodial Workers perform general cleaning services to State facilities using various cleaning equipment and materials in order to provide a safe, hygienic and orderly work environment. Incumbents possess a degree of knowledge and proficiency sufficient to perform work independently with little or no additional training.

Duties include dust/wet mopping; vacuuming; washing windows, doors, walls, and woodwork; cleaning and sanitizing restrooms; polishing furniture; and various duties as assigned. Applicants must have the ability to read, write, and follow oral and written instructions; operate various powered equipment used to scrub, strip, wax, vacuum, and buff floors; perform basic repairs on custodial equipment such as changing belts, brushes, and replacing plugs; and possess knowledge of materials and equipment used in cleaning, as well as safe and proper methods of using/mixing cleaning chemicals.

***PLEASE NOTE:** UNLV keeps Custodial Worker I applications active for six months. The six-month period begins on the date that you apply for the position. At the end of the six-month period, your application will be withdrawn from the recruitment. At that time, if you would like to re-apply for the position you are welcome to do so.

Education and Experience Ability to follow oral and written instructions and perform physical tasks requiring moderate strength.

Special Notes 1) As part of the hiring process, applicants for positions in the Nevada System of Higher Education may be required to demonstrate the ability to perform job-related tasks.
